

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE BENCHMARK DATABASE

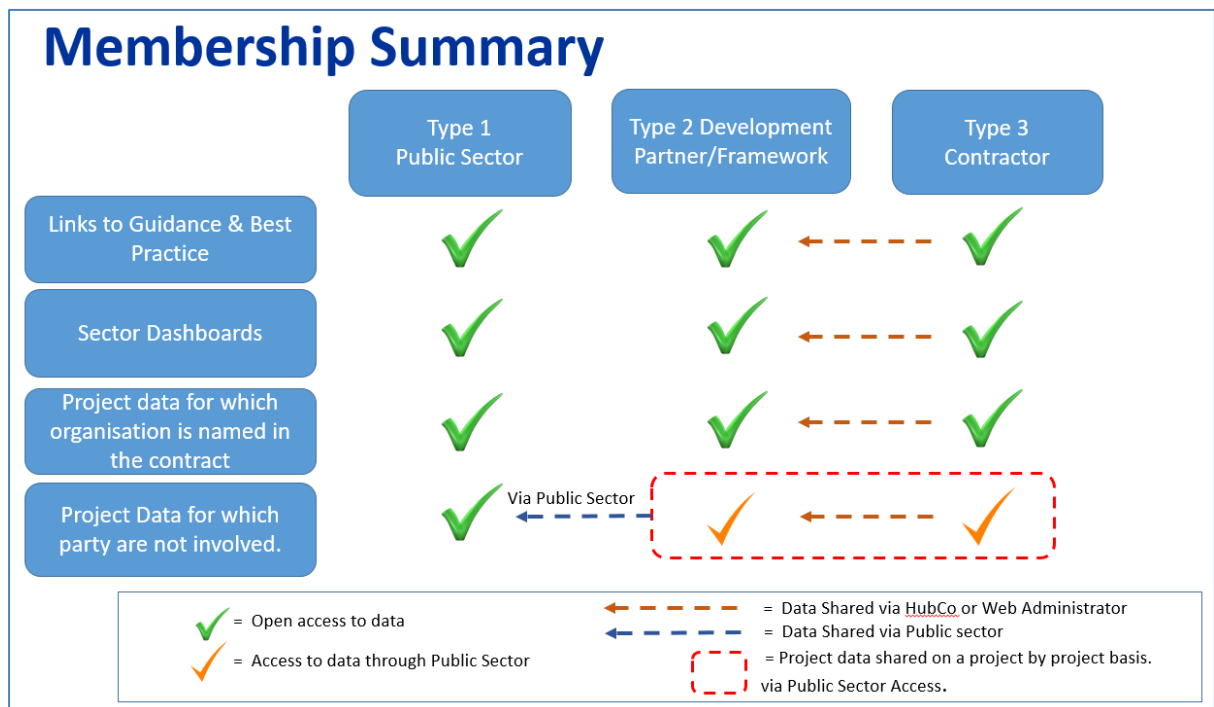
Membership Summary

Date: March 2017

The community infrastructure benchmark database facilitates the sharing of best practice and construction related project data amongst Public Sector organisations within Scotland. The membership of the database has been designed to support the sharing of information and also acknowledge the rights of the owners of the information. Therefore, the database operates three type membership system. This is set out as follows:-

- **Type 1 - Public Sector Membership** – This is membership to all public-sector bodies and provides open access to all information and projects on the database.
- **Type 2 - Development Partner/Framework Operators** – This membership is for all framework operators/development partners. This membership is tailored to specific organisations and allows access to projects that organisations have delivered. For example each HubCo would have open access to all project data for projects they have delivered.
- **Type 3 - Private Sector Supplier** – Type 3 members will not have day to day access to the database, however any Contractor can request all data for projects they are a named party too. This can be done by emailing the Benchmark Administration Team (benchmarkdata@scottishfuturestrust.org.uk)

The membership system and various types of data are summarised below:-



Sharing of data is fundamental to the success of the database. It is the intention that on a project by project basis, any project data can be shared by the public sector to support the delivery of that new project.
